The people of the Holston Conference have partnered with the people of South Sudan in ministry since 2005. Today, because civil war continues in South Sudan, our partners in ministry are trying to survive in Uganda.

This is a critical time in our relationship with the people of South Sudan. Because of civil war in South Sudan, the people have been displaced in Uganda since July 2016 in a refugee resettlement camp surviving with only the basic necessities in a dangerous situation.
